From Nicola Hamilton Principal Planning Officer Enforcement

I am aware that the Environment Agency has served a couple of notices on this site in relation to the environmental permit held by the company. One notice is to stop any further waste coming onto site and a second is to remove the waste currently on site within a given timescale. Last month, the EA have confirmed that they are currently actively monitoring these activities and compliance with its notices.

Reply from EA

Please see below response to your questions

1/ Can I ask what enforcements have been placed on the company and for how long, as work has started on the mounds.

On the 24 March 2025 the Environment Agency served a suspension notice on the company. The suspension notice prevents the acceptance of waste until specific steps have been taken. We want the operator to remove some specific non-compliant waste from the site and demonstrate that it has been done so legally. In addition, a regulatory enforcement notice remains in place that aims to reduce the volume of waste on the site.

That notice has been in place since November 2024 with monthly deadline dates up to the final deadline of 30 November 2025.

2/Do the employees have the correct protection ?

It is the company's responsibility to manage their own employee's health and safety however our staff when conducting inspections on site have felt safe with the correct personal protective equipment on areas of the site which are accessible. The lead authority to assess safety on site is the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) who can be contacted if someone thinks a workplace could be a serious health and safety issue, here is the direct link and further information: [Tell us about a health and safety issue - Contact HSE](#) The Environment Agency can confirm that we have visited sites and observed unsafe working practices, these have been highlighted to the operator and we have made direct referrals to the HSE.

HALL LANE

Clerk contacted Croppers they think the agent was Frank Marshall estate agency. Estate agency due to data protection act will not give owners name but I have asked if they would pass a message to new owner. Hedges have been cut.

SIMONSWOOD HALL

Reply from Paul Chadwick planning enforcement officer. Ref E/2024/0213/LB.

I can advise that we have an ongoing enforcement investigation at Simonswood Hall and I've been visiting the property since December last year. LCC conservation officers have also accompanied me on visits and various works that require listed building consent have been noted.

In view of this an application from the owners has been requested and we've recently been contacted by their planning consultants who have given us assurances that an application will be submitted by the end of the month.

If we receive the application as assured, then we will withhold from considering further action until the application has been determined. However, if we do not receive an application then a decision will be made by LCC conservation team as to whether it is expedient to serve a listed building enforcement notice seeking any rectification works. I'll continue to monitor the site and will provide you with an update again in due course.

CIL

Clerk wrote to CIL

We have just received monies from yourselves. Can we use it for paying for the expense of setting up a Gov web page and Microsoft 365. Also, can we use it to pay for Simonswood signs on our boundaries. Can we try to obtain grants to pay for some of the cost alongside the CIL payment.

REPLY Thank you for your email. Unfortunately you will not be able to use the monies to pay for the expense of setting up a .gov web page and the purchase of Microsoft 365 as these items do not meet the CIL spending criteria for parishes, which is:

CIL monies can be spent on the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure, or anything else that is concerned with addressing demands that development places on an area.

The use of Neighbourhood CIL on the provision of signs is acceptable in principle but further details would be needed, such as would this work be carried out on highways land and do you have the relevant consent of the landowners, and what is the detail to be provided on the sign? This would prevent you from going to the expense of purchasing and installing signs which may be later removed if they are unauthorised.
